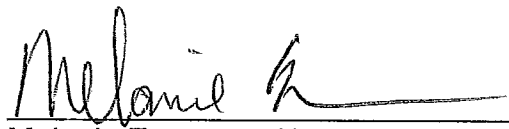
Mrs. Lingo inquires about pot holes. The street department has an ongoing list that they continue to work on.
