AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 SECTION 5.07 SUB SECTION C OF THE MT. HEALTHY EMPLOYEE POLICY MANUAL REGARDING MILITARY RESERVE LEAVE IN EXCESS OF 176 HOURS

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Chapter 5, Section 5.07, Sub Section C of the Mt. Healthy Employee Policy Manual is hereby amended to read as follows:

C. <u>Military Reserve Leave In Excess Of 176 Hours:</u> Any permanent public employee called to military duty for a period in excess of the one hundred seventy six (176) hours because of an executive order issued by the President of the United States, because of an act of Congress, or because of an order to perform duty issued by the governor pursuant to R.C. Section 5919.29, is entitled to be paid the difference between the employee's gross monthly wage or salary and the gross uniformed pay and allowances. If the gross uniformed pay and allowances equals or exceeds the employee's regular gross monthly wage or salary normally paid by the City, the employee is not entitled to any additional compensation from the City after being compensated for the initial one hundred seventy-six (176) hours per calendar year.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the first date provided by law.
