AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING COSTS OF THE REMOVAL OF TRASH AND DEBRIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 153.36, of the Codified Ordinances authorizes the city to cause the accumulation of trash and debris to be removed from any property located within the city when the owner of the property fails to cause such accumulation of trash and debris to be removed; and

WHEREAS, Section 153.15, of the Codified Ordinances authorizes the city to charge the costs of removing trash to the property owner or owners; and

WHEREAS, Section 153.15, of the Codified Ordinances further authorizes the city to certify to the county auditor the costs of removing trash collection as other taxes and assessments are collected when the property owner or owners have failed to pay the charges after due notification from the city; and

WHEREAS, the city has caused high grass or weeds to be trimmed and removed from several properties in the city and the owner or owners have refused to pay the costs thereof after having received due notification from the city;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Mt. Healthy, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. The following amounts have been charged to the properties listed below for costs incurred by the city in trimming or removing high grass or weeds:

Section 2. The amounts listed in Section 1 above shall be certified to the County Auditor for collection as other taxes and assessments are collected.

<u>Section 3.</u> The clerk is hereby authorized to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Hamilton County Auditor.

Section 4. This ordinance is declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is that immediate passage is necessary to meet the county's filing deadline for placing the amounts on the tax rolls for next year. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
