## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR THE MARTIN/HOFFNER, AND SUMME/SEWARD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Healthy desires to make paving improvements; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Mt. Healthy wishes to accept the lowest and best bid submitted by the J. K. Meurer Corp. of \$277,030.00; and

**WHEREAS,** the lowest and best bid is 6% higher than the engineer's estimate of \$260,000 put forth in the ordinance to advertise for bidding not to exceed \$260,000 including the cost for engineering design and preparation of contract documents of \$20,800.00 with the total cost not to exceed \$280,800.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the lowest and best bid for the Martin Street/Hoffner Street Improvement Project and the Summe Drive/Seward Avenue Improvement project, at a cost of \$277,030.00 together with the cost of engineering design and preparation of contract documents of \$20,800.00 having a total cost of \$297,830.00.

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and will take effect immediately upon its passage. The reason for the emergency is to begin construction at the earliest possible date.
