Healthy Police Department; and

**WHEREAS,** these complaints involve 3 Felonious Assaults (shootings), numerous calls for service relative to Gambling, Assault, Menacing, Disorderly Conduct, Soliciting, Intoxicated Individuals taking place on the premises; and

**WHEREAS,** such conduct caused disturbing annoyance and inconvenience to members of our community disrupting the peace and tranquility thereof.

**NOW THEREFORE,** BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1.** The City of Mt. Healthy hereby opposes the renewal of a liquor license to the business at 1357 Compton Rd. known as Take a Shot.
