Mt. Healthy Police Department made an employment offer to David Speers who accepted. His first day of work will be November 6th. He has experience with Gulf Manor PD and the UC Hospital. Officer Seehausen will return from military leave in November, which will help our staffing needs.

Thefts from vehicles and vehicle thefts continue to be an area of concern. Nationwide vehicle thefts are up close to 100% since 2020 due to the ease of theft of KIA and Hyundai models. Thefts from vehicles have continued to plague the country as well. We have encouraged residents to remove valuable property from their cars and garage them if possible.

We conducted an after-action meeting with Mt. Healthy Schools in response to the fake shooting threat in early October. Overall, the incident was handled well. However, some training points were identified including establishing the Incident Command System, reunification plans, and lockdown security protocol.

I conducted a meeting with Clovernook Apartment management. They informed us that they have updated their leasing agreements and made it easier for them to address problem tenants. They have also made a commitment to facility improvements including more lighting, landscaping and updated camera systems. We have noticed that our calls for service are trending towards "quality of life" calls that include traffic issues, noise complaints and unruly juveniles.
