ORDINANCE NO. 24-2039

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 20-1903 RELATING TO THE AMENDING OF CHAPTER 5 SECTION 5.07 SUBSECTION C OF THE MT. HEALTHY EMPLOYEE POLICY MANUAL REGARDING MILITARY RESERVE LEAVE IN EXCESS OF 176 HOURS

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2020, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 20-1903, thereby amending the Mt. Healthy Employee Policy Manual regarding Military Reserve Leave in Excess of 176 hours; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reconsidered such policy and wishes only to provide its employees the leave and/or benefits as provided in State and Federal law; and

WHEREAS, this City Council finds and determines that it is in the best fiscal interest of the City and its residents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY A MAJORITY OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 20-1903 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

Section 2. That the Mt. Healthy Employee Policy Manual is hereby immediately amended to reflect such rescission.

Section 3. That Mt. Healthy Employees are only entitled to military leave and/or benefits as set forth and required in State and Federal law; and

Section 4. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, fiscal security, and welfare of the City and the citizens of Mt. Healthy, Ohio. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval and after the earliest date provided by law.
