The Mt. Healthy Police Department was awarded full CALEA Accreditation in July. This distinguished award certifies that our police department adheres to best practices which cover all aspects of police operations, administrative functions and property management. CALEA reviews and certifies that our department is compliant with over 140 standards. This certification also ensures that the Mt. Healthy Police Department will comply with standards set by the Ohio Collaborative.

In July we welcomed Officer Joe Robers to the Mt. Healthy Police Department. Officer Robers comes from Springfield Township and has 6 years of experience. We also saw the departure of Officer Brad Williams who took a job with Springfield Township PD. We have 2 unfilled positions that we will be interviewing for in the next few weeks.

We have completed our full transition to 12-hour shifts. The transition has been smooth and the new working hours have been well received by the officers. The change has provided more supervisory coverage during peak operating hours.

A full property room audit was conducted on July 15th by our Records Manager, Steve Kramer, and our Property Management Officer, MaryLou Berning. The determination was that the Mt. Healthy Police Department property room had no deficiencies, and all evidence/property was accounted for.
