RESOLUTION NO. 22-1188

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY FOR LEVYING TAX EXCEEDING TEN-MILL LIMITATION AND THAT SUCH LEVY BE PLACED ON THE NOVEMBER 8<sup>TH</sup>, 2022 BALLOT AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Mt. Healthy, Hamilton County, Ohio, met on the 2nd day of August, 2022, at the office of Council Chambers for a Special Meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the City of Mt. Healthy, Hamilton County, Ohio for current expenses of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B)(1), this Council has received the County Auditor's a certification of certain matters in connection with a new additional tax levy attached hereto as Exhibit "A";

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Mt. Healthy, Hamilton County, Ohio, two thirds of all members elected thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1.** The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the City of Mt. Healthy, Hamilton County, Ohio.

**SECTION 2.** It is necessary to levy a new additional tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the City of Mt. Healthy for the purpose of providing current expenses of the City as described in Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code at a rate not exceeding 1.54 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifteen and four tenths cents (\$.154) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of tax valuation of the taxable property within the *entire* territory of the City, which only has territory in Hamilton County, Ohio.

**SECTION 3.** That the City Council hereby orders the question of levying such a new additional tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of said City of Mt. Healthy at the election to be held at the usual voting places within said City of Mt. Healthy on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022.

**SECTION 4.** That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B)(1), the County Auditor has certified to the City Council the total current valuation of the City of Mt. Healthy and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the number of mills specified as attached as Exhibit "A". Those amounts and rates are hereby accepted. In connection therewith, the City Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Board of Elections, along with a copy of the Auditor's certification at least ninety days prior to the General Election, and notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

**SECTION 5.** That the City Council hereby orders that the new additional levy shall be placed upon the current tax list commencing January 1, 2022, first due in calendar year 2023, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

**SECTION 6.** That this Resolution shall be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be in full force and effect from and after the first date provided by law. The reason for the emergency is to meet the filing deadline for the November 8, 2022 regular election.


**SECTION 7.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this City Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting, and that all deliberations of this City Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code; and that this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage to meet the Board of Elections deadline.
