RESOLUTION NO. 22-1195

**A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE TRANSFER
OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF LIQUOR CONTROL LICENSE
FROM PIT TO PLATE BBQ, LLC, TO STADIUM SPORTS BAR & GRILLE, LLC,
REGARDING THE BUSINESS LOCATED AT 8021 HAMILTON AVENUE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Mt. Healthy Police Department has received numerous calls and responded numerous times to complaints of disorder and illegal conduct being conducted by patrons of the establishment located at 8021 Hamilton Avenue since the Stadium Sports Bar & Grille, LLC, began operating and managing operations; and

WHEREAS, these complaints include, but are not limited to, shootings, fights, assaults, parking complaints, noise complaints, and/or suspicious activity, taking place on and/or near the premises; and

WHEREAS, such conduct has caused panic and alarm to members of our community and continuously created a disruption of the peace and tranquility in the City of Mt. Healthy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BE IT RESOLVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The City of Mt. Healthy hereby opposes the transfer of a liquor license for the business located at 8021 Hamilton Avenue from Pit to Plate BBQ, LLC to Stadium Sports Bar & Grille, LLC.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Department of Commerce Division of Liquor Control and the City Manager is authorized to execute any documents required to move forward with respect to objection/opposition to the above-referenced liquor license transfer.

SECTION 3. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the City of Mt. Healthy. The reason for the emergency is that immediate passage is necessary to present opposition to the above-referenced transfer of the Ohio Department of Liquor Control permit for the premises in question. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.

To whom it may concern:

The City of Mt. Healthy objects to the transfer of liquor permit from Pit to Plate BBQ LLC to The Stadium Sports Bar and Grille and its managing member, Mr. Daniel Oliver. The request for objection is based upon past public disorder, disruption of public peace and good order of the neighborhood, and the applicant's unfavorable enforcement record and operation in disregard of laws, regulations, and local ordinances. Mr. Oliver took control of the establishment and has used the liquor permit since January of 2022. Since then, the Mt. Healthy Police Department has responded to the establishment thirty-five times for calls for police service. Those calls include the following:

- One felonious assault, person shot
- Four reports of shots fired or a person with a gun
- One report of a sexual assault
- Six reports of fights or trouble between patrons and/or employees
- Two reports of motor vehicle thefts
- Three reports of auto accidents

The Mt. Healthy Police Department has also responded to the establishment for multiple reports of loud music, parking violations, and large disorderly crowds. On multiple occasions employees of The Stadium Bar and Grille have been uncooperative with the Mt. Healthy Police Department. Multiple requests for citations have been sent to the Ohio Investigative Unit, Cincinnati Division.

Furthermore, members of the Mt. Healthy Police Department have met with Mr. Oliver and discussed the multiple concerns. At this point we have seen no attempt on Mr. Oliver's part to
