Mt. Healthy Police Department received our official CALEA Accreditation Award. We are also completing our 24 hours of Continuing Professional Training as required by Ohio. We were able to receive \$6,900 in training reimbursement for the 2022 training year.

Car thefts and thefts from vehicles are on the rise. Kia and Hyundai models are targeted for their easy accessibility. Hyundai and Kia provided the Mt. Healthy Police Department with steering wheel locks to distribute. We have seen a decreasing trend in Part 1 crimes over the last few months.

Officer Korzan announced his resignation from the police department. He has taken a job with Miami Township Police Department, which is closer to his residence. We are currently conducting background investigations into two potential officers. We expect the return of Officer Seehousen, who is on active duty, in early November.

Pastor Kendall Washington and Pastor Whaley continue active Chaplains for the Mt. Healthy Police Department. Pastor Washington has assisted with call out for death notifications and is organizing a Trunk or Treat event and asked for our participation.

We have worked closely with Mt. Healthy Schools regarding the Home Coming Parade scheduled for October 5. The parade will start at 6:00 PM with short term road closures on Harrison Avenue and Hamilton Avenue.
