## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 76.04 OF THE MT. HEALTHY OHIO CODE OF ORDINANCES

**WHEREAS,** public complaints have increased from handicapped individuals as well as non handicapped persons regarding blocked sidewalks, stating the hazards of negotiating around blockages into the street, and

WHEREAS, public complaints have increased regarding cars parked up into the area between the curb and sidewalk causing maintenance problems and unsightly conditions, and

**WHEREAS,** the Property Maintenance Department has identified a useful improvement to the Mt. Healthy Code of Ordinance regarding Parking Prohibitions.

**NOW THEREFORE,** BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1.** That Section 76.04 subsections (A)(1) of the Code of Ordinances of Mt. Healthy, Ohio is hereby amended to read as follows:

## § 76.04 PARKING PROHIBITIONS.

- (A) No person shall stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to comply with the provisions of this title, or while obeying the directions of a police officer or a traffic-control device, in any of the following places:
- (1) On <u>or across</u> a sidewalk, <u>except as provided in division (B) of this section or the area between the curb and the sidewalk, except a bicycle;</u>
  - (2) In front of a public or private driveway;
  - (3) Within an intersection;
  - (4) Within ten feet of a fire hydrant;
  - (5) On a crosswalk:
  - (6) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;

- (7) Within 30 feet of, and upon the approach to, any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic- control device;
- (8) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless a different length is indicated by a traffic-control device;
  - (9) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
- (10) Within 20 feet of a driveway entrance to any fire station and, on the side of the street opposite the entrance to any fire station, within 75 feet of the entrance when it is properly posted with signs;
- (11) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
  - (12) Alongside any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
- (13) Upon any bridge or elevated structure upon a highway, or within a highway tunnel;
  - (14) At any place where signs prohibit stopping;
  - (15) Within one foot of another parked vehicle;
  - (16) On the roadway portion of a freeway, expressway, or thruway.

**Section 2.** That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the first date provided by law.
