ORDINANCE NO. 21-1946

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 77 (TRAFFIC AND PARKING) OF THE MT. HEALTHY CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, in order to empty trash containers in the alleyway that runs south off of Kinney Ave. between Maple Ave. and Werner Ave. Rumpke trucks require enough room to make the turn from Kinney Ave. into the alleyway, and

WHEREAS, if vehicles are parked on the north side of Kinney Ave. between Maple Ave. and Werner Ave. opposite the entrance to the alleyway, Rumpke trucks do not have enough room to make the turn into the alleyway, and

WHEREAS, there are two existing utility poles 101 feet apart on the north side of Kinney Ave. between Maple Ave. and Werner Ave. across from the entrance to the alleyway, and

WHEREAS, "No Parking Anytime" signs with arrows can be placed on these two utility poles solving the problem Rumpke trucks are having turning into the alleyway to empty trash containers.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Chapter 77: Traffic and Parking, Schedule I (A), Parking Time Limited or Prohibited, of the Mt. Healthy Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to include: "101 foot section of the north side of Kinney Ave. between Maple Ave. and Werner Ave. across from the alleyway running south off of Kinney between Maple Ave. and Werner Ave." As noted below.

SCHEDULE I. PARKING TIME LIMITED OR PROHIBITED.

(A) Parking on the following streets shall be limited to the specified times listed.

(B) The City Manager shall, upon direction of Council, have the power and authority to cause parking signs to be placed in city parking lots and upon city streets, designating limitations upon the permitted time periods for continuous parking, and it shall be unlawful to place or park an automobile, truck, or other vehicle for longer than the period designated by any such signs.

(C) Whoever violates any provision of this schedule, for which another penalty is not specifically provided, shall be fined not more than \$50 for each offense committed.

Section 2. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the first date provided by law.
