ORDINANCE NO. **21-1948**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CERTAIN RATE OF PAY FOR THE POSITION OF
PART TIME POLICE CADET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Mt. Healthy Police Department has identified the need for establishing the part time position of Police Cadet at a certain rate of pay.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the hourly rate for the newly created Part Time Police Cadet position be established at \$15.00 per hour.

Section 2. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and will take effect immediately upon its passage. That this Ordinance is an emergency and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest date allowed by law. The reason for the emergency is to hire a qualified candidate at the earliest possible date.

Section 4. That the City Council by a $\frac{3}{4}$ majority vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that the Ordinance be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Ordinance upon its first reading.
