ORDINANCE NO. **21-1949**

AN ORDINANCE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO APPROVE THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE ADAMS/HICKMAN/ELIZABETH STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Healthy desires to make paving improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Healthy wishes to advertise for bids and enter into contract with the lowest and best bidder for the Adams/Hickman/Elizabeth Street Improvement Project, not to exceed \$1,600,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the Adams/Hickman/Elizabeth Street Improvement Project.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary actions for the negotiation and creation of a construction contract with the lowest and best bidder for the Adams/Hickman/Elizabeth Street Improvement Project, in an amount not to exceed \$1,600,000.

Section 3. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and will take effect immediately upon its passage. That this Ordinance is an emergency and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest date allowed by law. The reason for the emergency is to begin construction at the earliest possible date.

Section 5. That the City Council by a ¾ majority vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that the Ordinance be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Ordinance upon its first reading.
