ORDINANCE NO. 21-1964

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY FIRE DEPARTMENT CHIEF TO SIGN A PURCHASE ORDER TO PURCHASE ONE (1) AMBULANCE BOX/PATIENT COMPARTMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$138,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Mt. Healthy Fire Department is in need to update one of its aging ambulances; and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to provide for the funding of said purchase.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$138,000 (cost of unit, options, delivery, and warranty) for the purchase of one (1) Ambulance Box/Patient Compartment for the Mt. Healthy Fire Department, through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, Vendor: Penn Care, 1317 North Road, Niles, Ohio 44446 and as further described in Exhibit A attached hereto.

Section 2. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the first date provided by law.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. The reason for the emergency is that immediate passage is necessary to speed up the wait time for this purchase. This Ordinance

shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
