AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXTEND EMERGENCY CURFEW FOR JUVENILES WITHIN CLOVERNOOK APARTMENTS UP THROUGH DECEMBER 1, 2021

WHEREAS, due to a number of violent incidents including, but not limited to, multiple shootings, stabbings, and other felony offenses which have occurred over the past few months within the area known as the Clovernook Apartments over the as further detailed in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, City Council passed Ordinance #21-1959 on August 19, 2021, enacting an emergency curfew for the area known as the Clovernook Apartments as detailed in Exhibit "A" up through October 5, 2021, which has been effective in curbing violent activity in that area; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief and City Manager have continued to be in contact with owners and management of the Clovernook Apartments for the purposes of executing a plan to address, reduce, and/or cease the aforementioned violent activity occurring with the Clovernook Apartments and believe extending such curfew is necessary for such plan; and

WHEREAS, juveniles existing within and/or entering into the Clovernook Apartments who may not necessarily be residents of either the Clovernook Apartments or the City of Mt. Healthy continue to be identified as a contributing factor to the above-referenced recent violent criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief, City Manager, and owners and management of the Clovernook Apartments believe extending the current curfew for an additional period of time as set forth in City Ordinances §§132.25 through 132.33, to include all times from 9:00pm to 6:00pm for all juveniles and minors within the Clovernook Apartments is a valid police power which rests with the City of Mt. Healthy and is necessary to continue to help reduce and/or cease the above-referenced recent violent criminal activity and protect the health, safety, and overall welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to extend the emergency curfew for juveniles within the Clovernook Apartments whose boundaries are detailed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto for juvenile/minors not with a parent or guardian between the hours of 9:00pm and 6:00am with the exception of going to their residence located within the Clovernook Apartments up through December 1, 2021.

Section 2. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That the City Council finds this Ordinance to be an Emergency necessary to protect the health, safety, and overall welfare of the City and its residents and by a ¾ majority vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that the Ordinance be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Ordinance upon its first reading. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the first date provided by law.


