A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF MT. HEALTHY, OHIO TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TRANSIT INFRASTRUCTURE FUND PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS the Transit Infrastructure Fund Program provides funding for the general construction or maintenance of roads, bridges and related facilities involved in the provision of transit service by the regional transit authority, and

WHEREAS the CITY OF MT. HEALTHY is planning to make capital improvements to Harrison Avenue, and capital improvements to other infrastructure in the City that may deem necessary, and

WHEREAS the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Transit Infrastructure Fund,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the CITY OF MT. HEALTHY:

Section 1: The CITY MANAGER is hereby authorized to apply to the Transit Authority for funds as described above.

Section 2: The CITY MANAGER is authorized to enter into any agreements with the Transit Authority as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance/Resolution were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations

of Council which resulted in the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. That this Resolution/Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the first date provided by law.
